The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.121 dated 28.10.2023 registered under Section 292 IPC and Section 67 of Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders dated 25.01.2024/13.08.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 25.01.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and
