1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 11.05.2022 (Annexure P-6) whereby respondent No. 2 has forfeited two years increments with permanent effect.

2. Mr. Ashish Aggarwal, Advocate, at the outset, submits that petitioner does not press her prayer *qua* setting aside of forfeiture of two years increments with permanent effect, however, respondents may be directed to release her retiral dues which are withheld without any rhyme or reason.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that Competent Authority would look into claim of petitioner *qua* retiral benefits and release the same, in accordance with law, within 3 months from today.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
