SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.91 dated 15.11.2022, under Section 498-A, 406 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

2. Vide order dated 25.01.2023 passed by this Court, interim relief was granted to the petitioner. In pursuance thereto, although the petitioner has joined the investigation throughout but dowry articles were not returned. Since that date, he is asking for adjournment on one pretext or other other.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Parminder Singh, submits that the recovery cannot be effected from the petitioner as he is enjoying interim relief being granted continuously since January 2023.

4. As the dowry articles are not returned by the petitioner despite giving him interim relief and the matter is hanging fire since January 2023, therefore, no ground is made out to extend interim relief further, hence, present petition is dismissed.

5. In view of order being passed in the main petition, CRM-48665-2023 is also stands dismissed.
