The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.1056 dated 17.12.2023 for the offences under Sections 170, 171, 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station Hisar City, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, has very fairly informed the Court that though initially the petitioner, who is a man of criminal antecedents, had expressed his willingness to settle the matter with the complainant party, however, he had not been in touch with him despite the learned counsel making earnest efforts to get through him. He submits that in the circumstances, since he has no further instructions, the petition be disposed of on merits.
