The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.139 dated 14.12.2023 registered under Sections 420, 406 IPC, at Police Station Division E District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Mr. S.S. Majithia, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and has filed his power of attorney. The same is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.03.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
