The instant application has been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for seeking withdrawal of the present writ petition.

The above said application is supported by an affidavit of the petitioner himself. It has been averred in the application that the petitioner has paid the amount towards full and final settlement to the respondent Finance Company and has taken back the possession of the vehicle in question. Further, a No Objection Certificate has also been issued by the finance company. The letter of settlement, NOC, copy of letter regarding removal of insurance hypothecation etc. have also been appended alongwith the present application.

In view of the facts stated therein, the application is allowed and hearing in the main case is pre-poned and the writ petition is taken up on Board today itself.
