1. The present second petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.134 dated 09.10.2023 registered under Sections 4(1) & 21 (1) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulations of Development) Act, 1957 at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

2. Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab appears on advance notice and on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh submits that the petitioner did not approach the learned Sessions Court, Rupnagar for grant of anticipatory bail to him. The impugned order dated 21.10.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar indicates that there was no case registered at Police Station, Nangal and as such, the application filed by the petitioner before the said Court was dismissed as having been rendered

infructuous. It is further submitted that the petitioner is required in an FIR registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

3. Faced with the aforesaid situation, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to approach the learned Sessions Court, Rupnagar at the first instance for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
