Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the similarly situated employees have been granted benefit of regularization from their initial date of appointment, which benefit has not been extended to the petitioner while he was in service whereas, the said grievance has been raised by the petitioner in the year 1999. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents are under an obligation to grant the said benefit as granted to the similarly situated employees.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice, which is appended with the present petition as Annexure P/12, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

3. Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case the legal notice, which is appended with the present petition as Annexure P/12 has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a period of further 04 weeks.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
6. Ordered accordingly.
