1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking benefits of seniority, pay scale and pay fixation on account of the fact that other similarly situated Intelligence Assistant (Constable) who were selected in the same recruitment process, are getting high pay scale.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that although the petitioners have submitted a legal notice dated 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-7) but to no avail.
3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court submits that the State shall consider the claim of the petitioners and that a speaking order would be passed on the legal notice dated 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law.
4. In view of the above facts, the present petition stands

disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 13.07.2023 (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order expeditiously and preferably within a period of 4 months from today.
