This is a petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India filed by the plaintiff-petitioner assailing order dated 15.12.2023 (Annexure P-8) passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), S.A.S Nagar, Mohali, whereby the *status quo* order granted was vacated for non-compliance of order dated 11.10.2023, 02.11.2023 and 01.12.2023.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of present petition, the parties have affected a compromise and in view of the same, the plaintiff-petitioner has withdrawn the main suit vide order dated 05.11.2024. In view thereof, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and he thus, prays the same be disposed of as such.

3. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1, 6 and 7 affirms the aforesaid submission and raises no objection to the present petition being disposed of.
