1. The earlier regular bail application preferred by the present petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 20.12.2023 with the following order:-

“1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition. However, direction may be given to learned trial Court concerned to expedite the conclusion of trial.

2. The innocuous and *bona fide* prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted and the instant petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.

3. The learned trial Court concerned is directed to make all efforts to conclude the trial within a period of 6 months from today.”

2. The learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by SI Ranbir Singh informs this Court that out of total 22 witnesses, 16 witnesses have already been examined. Therefore, the trial is progressing in its right direction as per the direction issue by this Court.
3. No ground is made out to grant the asked for relief at this stage.
4. Dismissed.
5. All the pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
