1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take a decision on the justice demand notice dated 12.01.2022 (Annexure P-18) served on behalf of the petitioners through their counsel, for review and re-examination of the videography and data of the Radio Frequency Identification Devise (RFID) relating to the aforesaid 2.5 km race relating to the petitioners before finalizing the selection process in pursuance of advertisement No.4/2020 dated 30.12.2020.
2. Learned State Counsel has referred to Annexure R-3/1 to show that each of the petitioners have not been able to finish the race in the requisite time and thus, have been rightly disqualified. It is submitted that the selection process is also completed.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the abovesaid stand taken by learned State Counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of.
