On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Vide order dated 25.01.2023, petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial Court concerned within a week and move appropriate application for seeking bail and that in case the same is filed, the same shall be decided within a period of two-three days. Petitioner did not surrender in compliance of the afore-said order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner had fallen sick. Attention in this regard is drawn towards Annexures A.2 and A.3, report of the Kantvam Healthcare.

Adjourned to 29.01.2024.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court concerned on or before 30.11.2023. On his surrender, the trial Court shall consider the bail application of the petitioner, on being moved by the petitioner, within 3-4 days, in accordance with law.”

Till today, petitioner has not surrendered before the trial Court concerned as per the order dated 25.01.2023.

In view of the afore-said circumstances, the present petition stands dismissed.
