Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct the demarcation while acting on the representation dated 15.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.3 within a stipulated period preferably from one month from the date of direction issued by this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Harish Sharma, Kanungo, Dhauj, Faridabad has submitted that the demarcation as prayed for in the present petition has already been carried out on 01.03.2024 and thus, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Let the copy of demarcation report be provided to all the affected parties.

In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous. The parties would be at liberty to pursue their alternative remedies in accordance with law in case they have any surviving grievance.

In view of the disposal of the main case, there is no need to pass any order on application filed for impleadment of applicant Darshan Singh as respondent No.6, so CM-4281-CWP-2024 stands disposed of.
