MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.186 dated 09.10.2023 under Sections 384, 506, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

2. On 12.02.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked her to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case in hand and that too, on the basis of a disclosure statement allegedly suffered by co-accused Sehwaq Thakur, who stated that the stolen cash and gold articles had been handed over to the petitioner. Learned counsel submits that the only ground, on which the petitioner had been declined the concession of anticipatory bail by the trial Court was her non-cooperation with the investigating



agency.”

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 12.02.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.
- 4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harmesh Lal, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for her custodial interrogation.
- 5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.02.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
- 6. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
