The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.170 dated 29.06.2021 under Sections 326/34 of IPC registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that there is a delay of 11 days in registration of the FIR and moreover, the civil dispute is going on between the parties and the complainant has self suffered the injuries and lodged the present FIR due to the property dispute.

The learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is the main accused who is alleged to have given grievous injuries with sharp *datar* blow on the right leg of his own mother, as such, he is not entitled to anticipatory bail.
