AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Kuldeep Kataria @ Sandeep Kumar has filed petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 252 dated 28.06.2023, registered under Sections 120-B, 323, 324, 365, 367, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

2. As per the facts of case, Anmol complainant gave his statement to police that he had performed marriage with Arshdeep Kaur on 14.12.2022. He started residing at Kasimpur, District Khagaria, Bihar along with his wife. On 26.06.2023, he came to Hanumangarh by train and Happy came to pick him up on his Bullet motorcycle for going to Dabwali. When they reached railway crossing bridge, Sandeep Kumar @ Kuldeep Kataria hit their motorcycle with his car from backside, as a result, they fell down. Sandeep Kumar, Sohan Singh and Giani came out of the car, armed with sticks and spade and gave him beating. Thereafter, he was put in their

car. Happy ran away from the spot. He was taken to village Abubshahr canal and was beaten up. They poured petrol on his person with intention to kill him. Thereafter, they heard somebody coming in that direction and all of them ran away. He remained unconscious at night time and regained senses in morning. With the help of passerby, he came to Government Hospital, Dabwali and from there, he was referred to Sirsa. With these allegations, present FIR was registered.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner stated that he was granted *interim* bail vide order dated 31.01.2024. He has already joined the investigation and not required for any other purpose. Therefore, it is prayed that *interim* bail granted in his favour may be confirmed.

4. Learned counsel representing State confirmed that petitioner had joined investigation. After completion of investigation, challan is also presented on 17.07.2024.

5. I have considered the aforesaid factual position. Petitioner is not required for any other purpose. Therefore, considering the factual position, without expressing my mind on the merits of case, *interim* bail already granted in favour of petitioner Kuldeep Kataria @ Sandeep Kumar vide order dated 31.01.2024 stands confirmed, on the same terms and conditions as mentioned in said order.

6. Petition is accordingly allowed.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
