RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 28.11.2023 passed in CWP-26610-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 28.11.2023 passed in CWP-26610-2023 has since been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by the competent authority, vide speaking order dated 01.04.2024. Copy of speaking order dated 01.04.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
