1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the action of respondent Board in asking for willingness of petitioners for regularization as Assistant Line Man instead of Telephonist, on which they have been working for last two decades, in violation to the policy/instructions dated 03.01.1985 (P-1/T) and 06.11.1998 (P-6).

2. On 13.05.2024, counsel for the petitioners sought adjournment to get instructions from the petitioners as to whether any cause in the present petition still survives or not. Thereafter, the matter was adjourned on 28.09.2024 and 29.10.2024.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite her best efforts, she has not been able to get instructions from the petitioners.

4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for

non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the same in case any cause of action still survives.
