Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the FIR No. 196 dated 28.07.2019 registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code (Sections 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC added later on) at Police Station South Sector 34, Chandigarh and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the Investigating Agency has presented the final report against the other accused and the Investigating Agency has chosen not to send the petitioner for trial as an accused, as nothing incriminating was found against her, during the course of investigation.
