PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Learned senior counsel for the landlord does not dispute that in terms of order dated 22.01.2021, the vacant possession of the demised premise stands delivered by the tenant.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous. However, learned senior counsel representing landlord submits that the petitioner is still in arrears of rent. Landlord is granted liberty to avail remedy as per the impugned order qua arrears of rent.
3. In view of above, the present petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
4. Since the main case has been decided, pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed off.
