1. By way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India in the nature of mandamus, the petitioner has sought directions to the respondents to add the pending remissions which are awarded from time to time for decision of the representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) moved to the Superintendent of Jail, District Jail, Gurugram, in accordance with law taking into account the order passed by Haryana Government Jail Department dated 14.08.2015 (Annexure P-2) .
2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner after being convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment in case FIR No.992 dated 19.09.2006, P.S. DLF, District Gurugram, is lodged in District Jail, Gurugram. He further contends that in the light of the aforesaid order dated 14.08.2015 (*supra*) passed by the Government of

and a fresh custody certificate is to be issued for which he had moved representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.4 but till date no action thereon has been taken.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No.4 to dispose of the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-1) in accordance with rules in an expeditious manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and submits that the representation (Annexure P-1) will be disposed of in accordance with rules in an expeditious manner.

6. After hearing the respective submissions and the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 4-the Superintendent of Jail, District Gurugram (Haryana), to consider the averments made in the representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) and dispose of the same in accordance with the rules within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
