1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.165 dated 11.12.2023 under Section 24 of the Immigration Act and sections 420, 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.
2. Learned State counsel, at the outset, on instructions from SI Yogeshwar Sharma, has submitted that after registration of the FIR in question, an enquiry was carried out wherein the petitioner Tara Singh was exonerated as it was found that he had no role to play in the crime in question.
3. In view of the instructions received by the learned State counsel, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant petition and submits that he be permitted to withdraw the same.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
