DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(ORAL)

On 25.01.2024, following order was passed:

“The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.161, dated 29.12.2023 at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, under Sections 379-B(2), 323, 506 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the matter arises out of a scuffle between the neighbours, wherein the allegations are to the effect that the petitioner alongwith other co-accused slapped the complainant and an amount of Rs.6,500/- was snatched.

Notice of motion for 23.5.2024.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”



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Today learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 25.01.2024 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
