DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

[1] On 25.01.2024, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Present: Mr. Anirudh Singh Shera, Advocate for the petitioner.

By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,
petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.2 dated
03.01.2024 registered under Section 15 (Act No.61 of 1985) of Narcotic
Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station City Pehowa,
Kurukshetra.

As per prosecution allegations, 1.7 Kg of poppy straw was
recovered from co-accused Mandeep Singh, who in his disclosure
statement, nominated the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated on the basis of disclosure statement
of co-accused and that he has nothing to do with the recovered
contraband.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts
notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Copy of the petition be supplied
to him during course of the day.

Adjourned to 13.02.2024.

In the meantime, in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be
released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/

Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

[2] Today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 25.01.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[3] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 25.01.2024, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
