RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for not adhering to the undertaking/statement given on 13.08.2020, before this Court.
2. Counsel for respondents No.1 and 2, as is also reflected from the reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2, submits that necessary action, pursuant to the order dated 13.08.2020, has already been taken by the Punjab Pollution Control Board.
3. In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unaddressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.

6. Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
