The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners, who are living together since 16.01.2024 in a live in relationship.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Singla, APP, U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has also placed on record statement of a person residing at H.No.3532, Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh, which is attested by SI Malkit Singh, Police Station Mauli Jagran, Chandigarh on 25.01.2024 by one Adil son of Ilyas, who informed the police to the effect that this house belongs to our relatives and they are residing on the said address on rent and there is no person residing or was ever residing at this address in the name of Abhishek and the address given by petitioner No.1- Abhishek is incorrect.

No ground is made out as even an iota of threat perception is absent in the pleadings of the present petition as well as representation submitted to police authorities dated 22.01.2024 (Annexure P-3).

This petition does not inspire confidence of this Court as the petitioners did not approach this Court with clean hands and have rather made a serious attempt to mislead the Court.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as the petitioners did not approach this Court with clean hands.
