This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate protection to the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Surinder Kaur informs the Court that the petitioner No.2 was a minor girl and has joined the company of her parents on 03.02.2024, after Inderjeet Singh, petitioner No.1 was arrested in FIR No.14 dated 19.01.2024, registered under Sections 365, 212, 216, 363, 366 of IPC and Sections 6, 12 of POCSO Act at Police Station Shahzadpur, Ambala.
3. In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Surinder Kaur, nothing survives in the instant petition and the same is disposed off, having been rendered infructuous.
