The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.200 dated 07.10.2023 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 25.01.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 25.01.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
