**NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)**

1. Petitioner, who retired as Lower Division Clerk from the service of the respondents on 31.01.2022, has filed the present writ petition claiming pensionary benefits such as pension, gratuity, leave encashment etc.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for claiming the abovesaid benefits, petitioner has already submitted legal notice dated 19.10.2023 (Annexure P-2), which may be considered in a time-bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Harpriya Khaneka, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 19.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and if there is no legal impediment, necessary benefits shall be released to the petitioner within a period of one month thereafter.
