1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondent for willful and intentional disobedience of order dated 25.09.2023 passed by this Court in CWP- 21327-2023.
