RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 19.10.2023 passed in CWP-23806-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 19.10.2023 passed in CWP-23806-2023 has been complied with and the application filed by the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 15.11.2023. Copy of the order dated 15.11.2023 (in vernacular) produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order dated 15.11.2023 passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
