Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though notice of motion has been issued but no reply has been filed so far hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 21.07.2023, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-9 wherein all the pleas as raised in the present petition has been raised in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, the legal notice dated 21.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the

petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
