KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of directions upon the official respondents to transfer the investigation, in case FIR No. 0181 dated 30.12.2020, under Section 380 of IPC, registered at Police Station Maloya, District Chandigarh, to some senior officer of the rank of IPS, as the petitioner has apprehension that the investigation cannot be carried out impartially.
2. The learned PP for UT, Chandigarh, has caused appearance and informed this Court that the investigation in this case has already been completed and thereupon, a cancellation report was prepared and the cancellation report so prepared has already been approved by the SSP, UT, Chandigarh and very soon they are likely to present the same before the learned Ilaqa Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
3. In view of the statement suffered by the learned Public Prosecutor, no further action is required in the instant petition and, therefore, the instant petition is ordered to be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, if the petitioner has still any grievance left he may approach the learned Ilaqa Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned by filing an appropriate motion.
