MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned JMIC, Patiala, whereby he was declared a proclaimed person in case FIR No.258 dated 16.08.2015 under Sections 279, 427, 304-A of the IPC registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala, along with all consequential proceedings.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Luthra, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel

for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously, by the Trial Court, in accordance with law.
