Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 6 to decide the representation dated 21.03.2023 (Annexure P-4); to respondent No.7 to sanction the mutation on the basis of exchange deed dated 14.10.2000 and also on the basis of said judgment and decree dated 07.04.2006 (Annexure P-1) and further direction to respondent No.6 to decide the application dated 07.04.2022 (Annexure P-3).

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have already filed an application for sanctioning the mutation before the Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Majitha and the same is pending consideration from the last about two years.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Ms. Akshita Chauhan, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. On instructions, she has submitted that the proceedings are being conducted in accordance with law and notices have also been issued to the private respondents. She submits that as the private respondents have not appeared so far, thus, further proceedings could not be carried out. It is submitted that the proceedings would be carried out expeditiously in accordance with law.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6- Tehsildar-cum- Assistant Collector, Majitha to expedite the proceedings in the application filed by the petitioners and conclude the same expeditiously preferably within three months from today.
