1. Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside orders dated 08.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) and 13.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2 under Section 14 of Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (for short 'the SARFAESI Act') and letter dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-3) issued by respondent No.3 for taking possession of residential house of petitioner.

2. This petition had been adjourned on 24.01.2024 for 19.02.2024 as arguing counsel for petitioner was stated to be in personal difficulty. None appeared on behalf of petitioners on 19.02.2024 since lawyers had suspended work on that day and matter was adjourned to 01.04.2024. On 01.04.2024 learned counsel for respondent-bank (on advance notice) informed that a schedule of payment had been submitted by petitioners on 18.01.2024 but the amount of Rs. 8 lakhs to be deposited on 31.03.2024, had not been deposited. Arguing counsel for petitioners was not present and an



adjournment was sought, upon which this petition was listed for today. Today despite matter being called twice, none appears on behalf of petitioners. Learned counsel for respondent-bank submits that till date petitioners have not deposited any amount.

- 3. It appears that petitioner is not interested to pursue the matter any longer.
- 4. Writ petition is accordingly dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.
