Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner relating to allotment of land compromised in land measuring 75K 11M bearing Khewat/Khatani No.181/217/1, Khasra No.58 (75K 11M) situated in village Jahangir, Tehsild Nakodar District Jalandhar as despite repeated representation (Annexure P-4) addressed to the concerned authorities seeking allotment of the said property, no action has been taken by the authorities and therefore, prayer is to direct the concerned authorities to allow the claim of the petitioner while taking appropriate decision on the representation as submitted to the authorities.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the redressal of the grievance of the petitioner, he has already filed a representation dated 23.10.2023 (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2 but no action has been taken on the same till date.

Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and has stated that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner should file a fresh representation before respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be granted liberty to file a fresh representation before respondent No.3 i.e. the Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Allotment Commissioner, Nakodar and he be directed to decide the same after hearing the petitioner in a time bound manner.

After hearing both the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file his appropriate representation before respondent No.3 as prayed for within a period of ten days from today. If any such representation is filed by the petitioner within the stipulated period, then respondent No.3 i.e. the Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Allotment Commissioner, Nakodar is directed to hear the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of its filing.
