Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents No. 1 to 4 to get the FIR (Annexure P-1) investigated through some independent agency/higher police officials.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the FIR under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code was registered on 13.02.2023 and the Investigating Agency has not concluded the investigation till date.

Per contra, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rajesh Kumar submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the Investigating Agency has already concluded the investigation and prepared the cancellation report on 30.12.2023 and the same shall be presented before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate within a period of 06 weeks.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition and the the same is hereby disposed of accordingly. However, the petitioner would be

at liberty to file the protest petition as and when the final investigation report is

presented before the concerned Jurisdictional Magistrate, in accordance with law.
