In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though the grant of 2nd ACP has already been allowed in favour of the petitioner vide order dated 03.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) but the same is not being implemented and that too without any valid justification, hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner the benefit accruing to the petitioner as per order dated 03.04.2023 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that not only the 2nd ACP but even the petitioner is entitled for 3rd ACP for which the petitioner has moved a legal notice dated 15.12.2023, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-6 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 15.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
