1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India and Section 2 read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 27.12.2022 passed in CWP-30333-2022.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Dr. Ranvir Singh Arya, Principal, Govt. College, Birohar, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 27.12.2022 passed in CWP-30333-2022 has been complied with and speaking order dated 27.01.2024 has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same before the appropriate Court, in accordance with law.
