1. On the oral request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the offence under Section 201 IPC is ordered to be added in the first paragraph as well as in the prayer clause of the petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner is ordered to carry out the necessary correction in the Court today itself.
2. The appellant has filed the present appeal before this Court to challenge the impugned order dated 19.01.2024 passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, whereby, the anticipatory bail petition filed by the appellant was ordered to be dismissed in case FIR No. 754 dated 28.07.2023 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 of IPC (Section 120-B IPC added later on) and under 3(2)(va), 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of the SC/ST Act registered at Police Station Karnal Sadar, Karnal.
3. Vide order dated 01.02.2024, SHO, Police Station Sadar, Karnal was directed to inform respondent No.2 in writing with regard to the pendency

of the present appeal before this Court.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Nayab Singh submits that the respondent No.2 has been informed in writing with regard to the pendency of the present appeal, still there is no representation on behalf of respondent No.2.

5. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.02.2024 passed by this Court, the appellant has joined the investigation.

6. Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Nayab Singh, has submitted that the appellant has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

7. In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 01.02.2024 is made absolute. The appellant shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The appellant shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 Cr. PC.
