Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing termination letters dated 16.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) and dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) issued by respondent-Corporation to the petitioners dismissing them from their services.
2. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3, on instructions from the Corporation, submits that the impugned letters/orders shall be withdrawn with liberty to pass fresh orders, in accordance with law.
3. In view of the above, instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous. Disposed of accordingly.
