In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the disciplinary proceedings, which are being conducted qua the petitioner in respect of the allegations alleged against the petitioner, be finalized in a time bound manner as the petitioner is suffering prejudice as he is not being able to get his service benefits such as promotion as well as benefit under the Assured Career Progression Scheme due to the pendency of those disciplinary proceedings.
