RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction, especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant multiplier factor as 1.5 along with interest as per First Schedule of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

It is not even in dispute that the petitioner is having the alternate remedy to seek enhancement of compensation by availing all the legally available grounds. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to entertain the present petition, as such.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail his statutory remedies to seek enhancement of compensation, on all legally available grounds.
