This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for non-compliance of the order dated 18.10.2023 passed in CWP-23746-2023.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 filed in the Registry is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 18.10.2023 passed in CWP-23746-2023 has been complied with and necessary order dated 01.03.2024 has been passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
