NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners, who are outsourced employees, have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the notice dated 07.01.2022 (Annexure P-3) (colli) passed by the respondent-Service provider whereby the services of the petitioners on different post have been terminated w.e.f. 07.02.2022.

2. Learned State counsel submits that the present petition is squarely covered by a judgment of this Court dated 20.01.2024 passed in **CWP No.25061 of 2022**, titled as "**Manpreet Kaur Versus State of Punjab and others**" and **other connected cases**, wherein it has been held that writ petition against the service provider is not maintainable and liberty has been given to avail other legal remedies in accordance with law against the service provider.

3. Dismissed in the same terms as in **CWP-25061-2022** titled as "**Manpreet Kaur Versus State of Punjab and others and other connected cases**, decided on **20.01.2024**."
