This is a contempt petition filed under sub Section (3) of Section 12 read with Clause (b) of Section 2 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for issuance of contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 20.11.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-25469-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced the demand draft No.539929 dated 06.02.2024 amounting to Rs.25,000/- in favour of the petitioner. The original of the demand draft has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner. Copy of the same is taken on record.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.

Dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
