KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is for quashing of order dated 24.07.2017 (Annexure P-4), passed in a criminal complainant no.34, dated 28.02.2011, filed under Sections 148, 323, 324, 341, 427 and 506 read with Section 149 of the IPC, by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hoshiarpur, whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed persons

2. A co-ordinate Bench of this Court, at the time of issuing notice of motion vide order dated 30.01.2019, passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that his client is ready to deposit the costs of Rs.50,000/- with the Bar Association

of this Court and to join the proceedings before learned trial Court within one week.

Notice of motion returnable by 19.03.2019.

In case, petitioner surrenders before learned trial Court and moves an application for bail, he be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Costs of Rs.50,000/- be deposited within four days from today in the O/o Bar Association, Punjab and Haryana, Chandigarh. ”

3. What surface from the perusal of the order that the petitioner has also complied with the above direction and deposited the costs of Rs.50,000/-.

4. Learned counsel for complainant/respondent no.2 submits that much water has been flown as on 27.09.2019, the complainant/respondent no.2 caused appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, and withdrawn the complaint as the matter has been amicably compromised with the present petitioner.

5. Since the main complaint itself has been withdrawn, and the the matter has been amicably compromised between the parties concerned, no further order is required to be passed in the instant petition.

6. **Disposed of accordingly.**
