1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.05.2023 passed in CWP-9973-2013.
2. There is nothing on record to show that respondent No.4 has raised any construction, particularly, on the land of *Johar* (pond), as such. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
3. Dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
